We're taking orders now!!!**

**Stockhouse's Produce Subscription Service** runs from early May through late October. Members will receive weekly assortments of seasonal vegetables grown here on our farm. Delivery and the addition of cut flowers are optional. Weekly pick-ups are on Tuesday afternoons at the farm or we can deliver directly to you on Tuesday afternoons.

### **About Our Produce and Cut Flower Subscription Service :**

Our program is a form of community supported agriculture (CSA). In a world where food travels an average of 1,300 miles from the farm to stores, joining a CSA is a great way to support local farmers and get access to freshly picked, seasonal produce. In the last 15 years, CSA subscription farms have sprung up throughout the country in an attempt to reduce the loss of family farms to sprawling residential development. The development pressure on farm land is as great in Wahkiakum County and southwestern Washington as many places in the country. By joining our or other CSAs in the area, you help support the small farmer. Why pay up front? Because the major monetary investment on the farm is incurred in the spring....produce planning, seed purchase, tilling, planting, weeding, etc!

### What Will Stockhouse's Produce Subscribers Receive?

Each subscription includes a ample produce for two adults. The spring subscription (May-July) will include an assortment of produce such as artichokes, asparagus, strawberries, lettuce, peas, broccoli, carrots and other early crops. Your fall subscription (beginning in August), will consist of produce such as cucumbers, summer squash, tomatoes, beans, potatoes and peppers. As they ready, corn and winter squash will be added. The size of your weekly subscription will vary somewhat week to week, being more abundant some weeks and smaller others depending on what the garden has to offer! We're not listing everything we grow here....you'll be pleasantly surprised every week with our garden's offerings! And to help you prepare dinners, you'll receive at least one recipe every week!

**Dates:** A minimum of 20 weeks between May and October (possibly until early November if the weather is favorable).
